SHORTLISTED CANDIDATE FOR THE POSTS OF SR. TRAINEE / DIPLOMA TRAINEE:

A candidate shall be considered shortlisted for the post of Sr. Trainee / Diploma Trainee for further recruitment process only after securing minimum passing marks i.e. 35 marks out of 100 max marks of (Section 'A' + Section 'B').

FINAL MERIT LIST FOR THE POSTS OF SR. TRAINEE / DIPLOMA TRAINEE:

Final merit list shall be drawn for UR/SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates with reference to the post wise number of vacancies for each discipline i.e (Marketing, HR, Accounts, Agriculture, Quality Control, Horticulture Agriculture Engineering and Civil Engineering). Final merit list of suitable candidates shall be prepared on the basis of performance of shortlisted candidates in the written examination.
