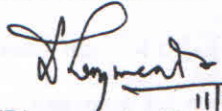

Dialysis Treatment	<p>Page No. 3, 4 & 5, Clause No. 4 C [vi] The maximum annual ceiling for reimbursement of OPD treatment by the employee and his family members in respect of [a], [b] and [c] shall be limited to a sum equal to one month's basic pay of the concerned employee or Rs.30,000/-, whichever is less. However, if any employee exhausts the above ceiling during the financial year due to extra expenses on special diseases specified at [b] above or post-operative follow up treatment specified at [c] above except C[vi] such additional claims for outdoor treatment in respect of [b] and [c] above, may be referred to F&A Department, Corporate Office on 1st and 16th of each month for consideration/special approval of the Competent Authority for the extra expenses incurred over and above ceiling.</p>	<p>Page No. 3, 4 & 5, Clause No. 4 C [vi] The maximum annual ceiling for reimbursement of OPD treatment by the employee and his family members in respect of [a], [b] and [c] shall be limited to a sum equal to one month's basic pay of the concerned employee or Rs.30,000/-, whichever is less. Hospital letter dated 27th February, 2014.</p>	<p>The credit letter to the empanelled Hospitals of NSC will be considered only in emergency cases to save the life. In all other cases reimbursement will be considered as per rules.</p>
